Vicarius Verba...

Greetings, I write this as the new school year has begun. I went to visit the classrooms; the new doors are impressive and the children were filled with smiles. It was great to see. Thank you for bringing your family to the Cathedral of Saint Joseph.

In this edition, Our First Reading from Isaiah writes, "to gather all nations and tongues". God comes to bring salvation to all of His people. The term "catholic" comes from the Greek katolicos, which means universal. The early Christian follower Justin Martyr, in his apology to Trypho, made a defense of the faith as opposed to what we more commonly know as "I'm sorry for something." His defense of the universal faith shows the form and layout of how we celebrate Mass, dating back to the early second century. His name, Martyr, comes from the Greek for "witness." Justin chose to follow, promote and defend this universal Christian faith, the followers of Jesus, and witnessed its authenticity as the way of life. He wrote to the Roman Senate, the powerful supreme governmental hierarchy at the time, which was in response to the persecution of Christians and the interest of the Christian way of worship, which is to say, our Mass. Christianity was not legalized until the Edict of Milan, circa 313 AD, (abbreviation for Annos Domini, Latin for the year of our Lord). Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen is noted for saying, "There are not over 100 people in the United States who hate the Catholic Church. There are millions; however, who hate what they wrongly believe to be the Catholic Church." Let us keep up the spiritual battle as we continue to pray for each other. Trusting in God's goodness, His care and protection for His followers. God bless, Fr. Becker
