A Word from Fr. Duc Nguyen

In our Gospel today, we hear the response of the people to Jesus' teaching on the Eucharist. We are at the end of the Bread of Life Discourse in John 6. They reject Jesus. They say that they cannot accept His teaching because it is too difficult to understand. They choose to stay in their worldview instead of opening their minds to the wonders Jesus has in store for them. They not only close their minds off to Jesus, but they close their hearts as well. They reject having faith—faith in the very one who was sent to bring them salvation. They failed to recognize the Son of God.

So, they leave. If you read Mark 6, John 6, and Mark 8, you will see that He goes to the Gentiles and performs the same works and teaches the same thing. Christ has compassion on those who left Him by letting them go (and not condemning them), but He also has compassion on the Gentiles because He will allow them to join Israel as the chosen people—the Church. He extends the New Covenant that He is about to make with humanity in one year's time to the Gentiles too. He will allow all of humanity to have the opportunity to eat of His flesh and blood, the Bread of Life, in one year when He will undergo his Passion and Death. They just need to have faith.

And we see the model of faith in the Apostles at the very end of the Gospel—especially in Peter. They do not abandon Him yet—they will abandon Him in a year. They see that Christ brings eternal life. I have been reflecting on if any of those who abandoned Jesus that day eventually did come back once they understood what he was saying in light of the Eucharist. I hope that many did—and they probably found forgiveness for it. Let us have that same faith and perseverance as the Apostles. We should go to Jesus who gives us the Words and the Bread of Everlasting Life.
