Message from Father Hansen:

I write today from southern Florida where I'm at a workshop with about 24 other clergy. Each day we have two meditations, some Liturgy of the Hours together, a rosary (prayed in the living room, family style), and classes in the morning and afternoon, except two excursion days. Last week I was able to go to NASA on an excursion day, and see a real rocket boost off. No people were on it. However, it was going to the space station with supplies and equipment for research. One company sending items was Goodyear Tire, intended for research in space for better quality rubber for tires! Daily Mass, a day of Recollection, and Holy Hours have been part of the workshop, too; I've been praying for you all! I heard nice comments about prayers for us and that there was a good turnout for blood donations last Saturday at the Knights of Columbus Hall - thank you!

In my last Bulletin article, I wrote about the Collaborative Steering Committee. I particularly wrote about Becky Evans and her husband Michael being on Committee.
