#### Message from Father Hansen...

I write you on Friday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Yesterday I traveled to Columbia for the Bishop LeBlond state championship in 8-man football. As I sat quite high in the stands at the middle of the field, I could not have been prouder of the kids (and their families and friends who traveled in great numbers) for the sportsmanship and effort. Earlier in the day, I had the chance to show Bishop Johnston a short video of the kids in Adoration at Our Lady of Lourdes in Columbia, with their chaplain and our vicar, Fr. Armentrout. Bishop Johnston said, "I hope they win the game, but even if not, that (that they did Adoration) is more important." Congratulations Bishop LeBlond Eagles for making it to the state championship! We're, I'm, proud of you!

Speaking of Bishop Johnston, he'll be coming for new Mass time on Christmas Eve. Instead of 3pm Socks and Mittens and 5pm Mass with the Bishop, we'll have a 4pm Mass with the Bishop where the children will bring up socks and mittens to be given to the poor! You'll be able to watch the Chiefs beat the Seahawks at noon and, when coming to Mass, be thankful for that, too!

Before ending, I now recall the tradition I learned we do at Cathedral School, which my parents did when I was growing up (very common in Scandinavian areas). Of course, we know the origins of the name <u>Santa Claus</u> are from <u>Saint Nicholas</u>. But the tradition of children putting shoes out the night of December 5<sup>th</sup> is done in the hopes to find small gifts on the morning of December 6<sup>th</sup>, St. Nicholas Eve, and day is one focused on giving over receiving, remembering those less fortunate, and that St. Nicholas loved children.

Have a wonderful St. Nicholas Day, and remember that Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is a Holy Day of Obligation. Happy Advent!
