A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

In the Holy See's "Decree on the Granting of Indulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year of 2026" we read:

"Now the time has come for a new Jubilee, when once more the Holy Door will be flung open to invite everyone to an intense experience of the love of God" (Spes non confundit, 6). In the Bull announcing the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025, at a moment in history in which "heedless of the horrors of the past, humanity is confronting yet another ordeal, as many peoples are prey to brutality and violence" (Spes non confundit, 8), the Holy Father calls on all Christians to become pilgrims of hope. This is a virtue which must be sourced above all in the grace of God and in the fullness of His mercy. It is to be rediscovered in the signs of the times which, encompassing "the yearning of human hearts in need of God's saving presence, ought to become signs of hope" (Spes non confundit, 7) ... And so, also during the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025, by will of the Supreme Pontiff, this 'Court of Mercy', which is responsible for all that concerns the granting and use of indulgences, wishing to encourage the souls of the faithful and nourish the pious desire to obtain the Indulgence seen as a gift of grace specific to each Holy Year, establishes the following indications, so that the faithful may take advantage of the "norms for obtaining and rendering spiritually fruitful the practice of the Jubilee indulgence" (Spes non confundit, 23)."

I'm happy to say that Bishop Johnston has submitted to the USCCB for their reference map of national Jubilee pilgrimage sites, the Cathedral of St. Joseph! Two additional sites are within our Diocese: the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception in Conception, MO, and the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City!!

The Holy See's Decree continues: "the faithful can obtain the Jubilee Indulgence if, individually or in a group, they devoutly visit any Jubilee site and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God, so that in this Holy Year everyone "will come to know the closeness of Mary, the most affectionate of mothers, who never abandons her children" (Spes non confundit, 24)."

Next week in the bulletin we will have more information about welcoming pilgrims during this Jubilee Year of Hope!!! Please pray for an extra outpouring of Hope for all who come!!!
