#### Father Hansen's message . . .

We continue our journey today in our brief period of Ordinary Time before Lent begins on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. I write this after preparing for Mass for Friday. In John 19:34 we hear that the Communion Antiphon for the Votive Mass of the Sacred Heart (which will be offered as it is the First Friday) as "But one of the soldiers pierced his side with a spear, and at once there came out blood and water."

The blood coming from our Lord's side represents the Eucharist and the water represents Baptism. These are two of the three sacraments of initiation, the third is Confirmation. These days, Arman Partamian has been working hard to get those in RCIA ready to receive those sacraments upon entering the Church at the Easter Vigil. Fr. Armentrout heard the CCD First Confessions recently, and he and I together heard them of the school children a month or so ago, preparing them to receive their First Communion. A couple Sundays a month I have the privilege of working with the high school freshmen in their preparation for Confirmation on March 20<sup>th</sup>.

Pope Francis has said we go "go back to our Baptism" and think of the conversion that happened there. We, like St. Paul, were knocked off the horse of sin (effects of sin for children) and became children of God. The Holy Spirit started dwelling in us, preparing us for what God would want of us. He wants all of us to give ourselves away in a way that will bring peace and joy to those around us; of course, starting in our families and with those close to us.

In our ordinary days, let's be thankful for the sacraments' initiation that "initiate" us as Christians in the Catholic Faith!
