Message from Father Stephen Hansen –

I'm asked quite often, "How many times a year do you see your family?" On the one hand, each day I see my family, so many people call me Father. I'm able to Baptize, hear Confession, offer Mass, and Marry and Bury. What a joy it is to be a priest. It's a joy to work with the larger family, too, with Fr. Fenlon, Fr. Nguyen, and Xavier. What a joy to have fathers in our Bishop and Holy Father.

I usually, however, answer the question about seeing my family as relating to back in Wisconsin. Each year my siblings get together with all their families on Christmas, Easter, a Fall bonfire at my brother Patrick's, and when I come home each summer. When my parents were living, I went "home" twice a year. After my father died, I started this tradition of going home once a year in the summer, but would also bring my mom out to the parish in the Spring or Fall. Well, I'm flying to Wisconsin next Saturday for the last bonfire at my brother's (as he's retiring and moving). I hope you'll be extra nice to Frs. Nguyen and Fenlon, and to Xavier. I think of Frs. Nguyen and Fenlon coming from farther lands than Wisconsin. As brothers and sisters in Christ, may we continue to support those without families, and enjoy those with families who are close to us. May we see in this broader family we call the Church, a Blessing like none other!

Please join in on the Immaculate Conception (and Advent) Novena which begins Saturday. The Novena will be emailed to everyone and available in the Cathedral and St. Mary's. Hesitate not to begin on Sunday by doubling up if you don't start on Saturday. Please pray for me and my earthly family in your Novena, I'll be praying for you and yours! Have a wonderful Advent!
