Father Hansen's message . . . It is good to be back to St. Joseph after my 16-day trip to New York and Wisconsin. Every time we step away from our ordinary work for a recreating work, like my Workshop in New York, we experience a newness of life given. What a joy it is to serve as a priest. What a joy it is to bring newness of life to my attempts to serve you. Please forgive me for my many failings in my serving and pray for me as I asked in my article before leaving.

I write this on the feast of Martyred Claretians of Barbastro (<u>http://www.claret.org/en/calendar/august-13-blessed-claretian-</u> <u>martyrs-of-barbastro/</u>) – August 13th, 2020. These martyrs (which you can learn more about on the link above) were nourished by the Eucharist smuggled into the seminary prison in sandwiches in a picnic basket.

From the article: "In jail the missionaries prepared themselves for execution. One wrote that they spent the days in religious silence, and when they did speak, it was to encourage one another to die as martyrs. Yet there was the holy murmur of prayer, particularly prayer for the forgiveness of their jailers. "Save them, Lord, for they do not know what they are doing!" They also prayed the Liturgy of the Hours and the rosary. For the first few days, the young missionaries clandestinely received communion, the center of their lives and their source of strength. ... Between August 2 and 18, fifty-one members of the Claretian community of Barbastro went to their deaths. The nine whose lives were spared were elderly or infirmed, and two Argentinean students, who were released and sent back to their country, after spending three weeks in prison with their peers."

We have a chance to Adore Jesus in the Eucharist at the Cathedral and St. Mary's (in addition to at the MIR House).
