#### Message from Father Hansen . . .

Today we celebrate the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. Next week will be the end of the Liturgical Year, the Solemnity of Christ the King, and after that we begin Advent! If today were not a Sunday, it would be the Feast of St. Albert the Great. He was a teacher of the great Saint, Thomas Aquinas. St. Albert is one of the patron Saints of schoolchildren and no doubt that plays a role in November 8-14 being designated "Discover Catholic Schools Week" (the traditional Catholic School Week will still be celebrated during the last week of January)!

Friday we celebrated the Memorial of St. Frances Xavier Cabrini. The prayer at the beginning of Mass (called the Collect) was "God our Father, who called Saint Frances Xavier Cabrini from Italy to serve the immigrants of America, by her example, teach us to have concern for the stranger, the sick, and all those in need, and by her prayers help us to see Christ in all the men and women we meet."
