Father Hansen's Message . . .

Today we begin Advent! In the past eight months, we could say we have been in a king of advent, an arrival. This excerpt from an article on Advent might be good for reflection as we begin this Holy Season: *The word "Advent" stems from the Latin word adventus, which literally means "coming" or "arrival." In context, this commonly refers to the coming of Jesus on Christmas day.*

The Catechism of the Catholic Church confirms this double meaning, "When the Church celebrates the liturgy of Advent each year, she makes present this ancient expectancy of the Messiah, for by sharing in the long preparation for the Savior's first coming, the faithful renew their ardent desire for his second coming" (CCC 524).

There is even an ancient tradition that says Jesus will come again during the Advent season. For this reason, as we prepare for the celebration of Christmas, we recognize that Jesus could come again at any time, and prepare our own hearts to receive him when he does.

Just before the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, we will have a small parish mission for St. Mary's and Cathedral and any visitors. One of the Franciscan Friars of The Renew (https://www.franciscanfriars.com/) will be preaching/giving talks. We will update you next week on the details!
