# Message from Father Hansen . . .

Today we celebrate the 29<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. It is fall break for a lot of students, and this past Monday we celebrated a national holiday, Columbus Day. I am a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Knight of Columbus and proud to be! Additionally, I am chaplain for a Council and for the 4<sup>th</sup> Degree in the area. Over the years I have been moved by the presence of the Knights in parishes I have been assigned to and at such activities as the Pro Life March in Washington, D.C. and World Youth Day (in Poland when we got off the bus for the first time there they were). Recently I received an email from the national office of the Knights of Columbus. The text and links within the email are posted below. I highly recommend the ½ hour documentary to you. Some are in favor of removing the Columbus Day from the Holiday list in the United States. You will see why I am in favor of keeping it after this short film.

COURAGE AND CONVICTION: The True Story of Christopher Columbus is a thorough examination of the life and legacy of the fearless discoverer of America. Produced by the Knights of Columbus and narrated by actor Chazz Palminteri, this film provides insight into Christopher Columbus' remarkable genius as a sea navigator as well as his deep desire to bring all nations to Christ. If you missed Sunday night's premiere on EWTN, you can now watch this documentary at KofC.org/Columbus and on our YouTube channel. Through expert interviews and archival footage, we look at the origins of Columbus Day and the symbolic role that Columbus has for Catholic immigrants, especially Italian Americans. Finally, the film addresses the current indictments against Christopher Columbus with boldness and exposes the motives behind the attacks of revisionist historians.

"Courage and Conviction" shows why Christopher Columbus remains not only a man worthy of admiration, but a noble icon of what it means to be a Catholic and an American.
