This weekend, we are celebrating the **Anniversary of the Dedication of our Cathedral**. Work on the Cathedral began in 1869, and the first Mass was celebrated on St. Patrick's Day, March 17, 1871. Because of an oversight, neither our Cathedral, nor the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City, was formally consecrated. This oversight was corrected in 1975, when the two Cathedrals were solemnly dedicated (the rite formerly known as consecration) on successive Sundays, Feb. 2 (KC) and Feb. 9 (St. Joseph) by Bishop Helmsing. It was later decided that the anniversary of this solemn dedication shall be celebrated annually on the Sunday immediately preceding the Feast of All Saints.

Message from Father Hansen . . . This week we celebrate at the Cathedral the Anniversary of its dedication. Because that took place in March (Lent) in 1871 the celebration is moved to the Sunday before the Solemnity of All Saints. What does it take to be a Saint? Frank Duff, founder of the Legion of Mary, wrote a small book, “Can We Be Saints?” One of the bits of advice Frank Duff – whose Cause for Beatification and Canonization is now open, and he is a Servant of God – gave was to have a “day in detail.” St. Josemaria – whose first-class relic is in the back of the Cathedral – called it a “plan of life.” One of the elements of the day in detail/plan of life - allowing us to be close to God and discover his will, and become Saints, is mental prayer. I believe it was St. Teresa of Avila who coined that phrase. Mental prayer is about quiet time with God (preferably in front of His real presence in the Monstrance or Tabernacle) and getting acquainted with Him and ourselves. We then are more apt to be able to please Him (who we discover in prayer) and give ourselves (who we discover more deeply in prayer, too) away. As we are about to begin Advent, maybe you would consider picking up the New Testament (starting in Matthew) and putting it near a spiritual book you have been wanting to read, and just read for maybe 5 minutes total (both books) per day. Then, set another timer (maybe for 5 or 10 minutes) and take something that struck you to prayer with Jesus. After the time is up, try to make a resolution (something you want to do, not do, or do differently). It will be a great Advent and an amazing Christmas! Happy Anniversary!
