Father Hansen's Message . . . I write this on Thursday, September 17th, 2020.

Today marks the retirement of twenty-seven years of combined service to Cathedral by Kitty Spafford and Paula Bokay. Paula has been in the office for over sixteen years and have assisted with practically every job in the office. Her extra efforts with weekend and outside office Cathedral work has shown a commitment that has been extraordinary. Thank you, Paula!

Recently I was celebrant and homilist in St. Louis for the funeral of one of my best friends from Kenrick-Glennon Seminary's dad. John was an amazing man. Visiting with the family before the funeral I was read a letter from a gal, recalling how John taught CCD/PSR at the parish when she was a little girl. She remembered how he "showed up to teach week in and week out". She alluded to the fact that maybe she "was from the other side of the tracks"; indicating she felt that John was from a better side. John never talked about "what he had done"; he just did it and did it quietly and never thinking he was from a better side...

I am so thankful for the hard work put in to getting this school year off. Teachers like Sara Lile stepped up in Mrs. Martin's absence due to COVID quarantine. Pius and Fr. Leete stepped up for Leroy. I am also so thankful for the hard work put in for the CCD/PSR program.

Kitty has been working in the office for eleven years. Besides helping in the office, working in and around the Cathedral with the Masses, and for many years visited the sick and homebound and led communion services . . . she has been, among other things, the Protecting God's Children officer. Two things that also stand out: like John, her commitment to CCD/PSR and her work with the food pantry. In the last two years alone twelve and seventeen CCD children (as I recall) have made their First Communions along with the school children. Some of these children are immigrants and others long-term St. Joseph residents/parishioners. All treated with respect and dignity, never considered from the other side of the tracks. She has overseen the growth of the Cathedral Food Pantry, now a place that Monday, Wednesday, and Friday those in need not only receive food and clothing but smiling/welcoming faces. Thank you, Kitty!

I applaud Paula and Kitty for their service and commitment to Cathedral! May they be rewarded in this life and the next for their efforts!
