Father Hansen's Message . . .

I write on Thursday, September 3rd, and when you read this I'll be visiting with my brothers and sisters and their spouses for the first time since last summer. I come from a family, imperfect as it is, just like all of you. None of us has it all figured out... Of course we have the Holy Family to welcome into our families and our daily lives. I've been trying to ask what would the Holy Family think of this or that...? Or, would they feel welcome here or there...?

This past week Fr. Leete, Pius, and I had the privilege of sanitizing the restrooms at prescribed time during the day. The reason to sanitize between cohort use of facilities is to minimize the spread of germs in general and, in our times of COVID, if the virus is present. What a great vocation we have - all of us in all we do that is noble - to be called by God to offer every noble act to Him. From sanitizing restrooms to cooking to teaching, if the work makes life better for someone, it can be offered to God!

When checking temperatures in the morning as the school children arrive, to using the walkie talkie in the afternoon while calling out names so the children can meet their rides, I was able to see the faces of the parents and grandparents who were also off to do noble work . . . this really was touching to me. On Labor Day Monday, during this COVID time, we will give thanks for the chance to labor when many of us were unable to do so for a time.

Speaking of Labor Day, please remember to be aware of policies that can help reduce COVID spread this holiday weekend. I know that, in normal times, Labor Day weekend is often spent traveling and getting together with friends and family. I am asking as you join with your friends, family, and travel, you keep in mind your moral obligation to do so safely. Our school, for example, has worked hard on policies to reduce the incidence of COVID cases or exposure to COVID cases so that our children can remain in school as much as possible. Please be creative and find ways to do activities while following guidelines of social distancing and wearing masks when interacting with people outside of your families.
