Reflection from Father Hansen....

"As you kneel at the feet of the child Jesus on the day of his Epiphany and see him a king bearing none of the outward signs of royalty, you can tell him: "Lord, take away my pride; crush my self-love, my desire to affirm myself and impose myself on others. Make the foundation of my personality my identification with you.""

Today is Epiphany Sunday and these words are of one Saint about today's feast. Making the foundation of our personalities identified with Jesus is not easy, but we're all called to it. In this New Year let's consider how, by the end of the year, we could have advanced in this. My deacon assignment was at St. Andrew's parish in Gladstone. Msgr. Joe Mancuso was the pastor and one year he asked all the parishioners to put their goals for growing in identity with Jesus in envelopes. The goals were put in a big case in the front of the church. My recollection is they were returned at the end of the year. We're not doing that (at least this year) but the idea is wonderful. The gifts brought to Jesus at Epiphany no doubt made Jesus and the Holy Family smile. Let's ask ourselves individually today, what can I do differently in my relationship with God, within my family, where I work and/or volunteer? How will the "foundation of my personality, my identification with Jesus" grow this year?
