Father Hansen's message... I pray your Christmas was full of blessings, despite the many sicknesses going around, the loss of loved ones, and many other difficulties that can arise in the heart at Christmas... Jesus always will help us overcome... Today we conclude the Christmas season with the Baptism of the Lord.

St. Augustine said in a sermon, "The Lord desired to be baptized so that he might freely proclaim through his humility what for us was to be a necessity." Do you know the date of your Baptism? Are you considering being baptized or having children Baptized?? Whether you've been Baptized or will be, the date is a good thing to remember. Some call it their second birthday. I was born on July 27th and was Baptized on August 12th. Each year I celebrate that day my parents brought me to St. Lucy's church in Racine, Wisconsin, with my godparents to give me to God! To begin the journey of our Lord overcoming in my life. The Second Vatican Council proclaimed in section 64 that "The Church indeed, contemplating her hidden sanctity, imitating her charity and faithfully fulfilling the Father's will, by receiving the word of God in faith becomes herself a mother. By her preaching she brings forth to a new and immortal life the sons who are born to her in baptism, conceived of the Holy Spirit and born of God."

Wow, those are powerful words, that the Church "brings forth to a new and immortal life the sons (and daughters) who are born to her in baptism..."

The Catechism, section 1213, says: "Holy Baptism is the basis of the whole Christian life, the gateway to life in the Spirit (vitae spiritualis ianua), and the door which gives access to the other sacraments. Through Baptism we are freed from sin and reborn as sons of God; we become members of Christ, are incorporated into the Church and made sharers in her mission: "Baptism is the sacrament of regeneration through water in the word.""

Let's never take for granted this "basis of the whole Christian life" given to us. Let's ask for an outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives, renewing the gifts of the Holy Spirit given to us in Baptism, and sealed and strengthened in Confirmation. Thank you, Jesus, for humbling yourself so we know what we need to do!
