Sisters in Jesus the Lord

We hope you had a very Merry Christmas and that this new year will be overflowing with the Lord's blessings. We are so grateful for you! We think of you often and pray for you every day.

This has been a very joyous Christmas season! Our university students were on break December 25-January 8, so we celebrated Christmas especially with them. We started with Masses in Russian on Christmas Eve and day, then in English and Spanish on Christmas day afternoon. On New Year's Eve, we had a Mass with the students and all-night adoration. Several of the most special times were singing the liturgy of the hours with the students in three- and four-part harmony at our convent and caroling at a local mental hospital with our parish choir.

Last Sunday, January 11, we hosted the annual Christmas festival of Christian choirs at our church, with choirs from the Armenian Apostolic church, the Lutheran church, a Methodist church, and a Presbyterian parish all singing with our Russian Catholic parish choir in a free concert, followed by tea together.

This week, January 18 through the 25th, our church celebrates the week of Christian Unity. This year, the theme was chosen by the Armenian Apostolic Church-- Ephesians 4:4: "There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling." Please pray for all Christians to be reunited under Peter, our holy Father in Rome. Here is a prayer from an Armenian saint:

O Jesus Christ, Light from the Light, dwell within us, who have come together to worship your holy and precious name. Let your life-giving radiance kindle within us a deeper love for one another. May your brilliant light stir us to ever more flourishing unity. Like diverse flowers in the garden of your Kingdom, may your divine brilliance cause us to bloom in harmony. And so, all as one, may we always joyfully praise and glorify you, and the Father and the Holy Spirit, now and always and unto the ages of ages. Amen. (Adapted from St Gregory of Narek)



What is the Welcome Retreat?

Welcome is a two-day renewal weekend unlike any you have attended. Parishioners share with one another ways they have found meaning, hope, peace, and love in their lives through Christ. The experience is personal, inspirational, and fulfilling. This is the perfect way to establish a deep relationship with Christ and fellow parishioners in the comfort of our own parish facilities.

What happens during the retreat?
