Mother Stella's message . . .

Hello from SEEK 2023, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS) conference held in St. Louis Jan. 2-6. Save the date for next year—SEEK 2024 will be January 1-5, again in St. Louis! More than 17,000 people are here from across the United States, and from Austria, Germany, and Ireland as well. Thinking about the Magi, the three kings who found baby Jesus today, on the feast of the Epiphany. It is beautiful to reflect on this antiphon from evening prayer for Monday, January 2: "O radiant child! You brought healing to human life as you came forth from the womb of Mary, your mother, like the bridegroom from His marriage chamber." Jesus brings healing to each of us through His birth into this world and through His entrance into our hearts through baptism. He loves us so much! One of the speakers on the first evening brought a little child out on to the stage. As she held him in her arms, she said that Jesus speaks words of love to each of us, the way we speak words of love and tenderness to babies. We would be shocked if anyone started saying to a baby that he is ugly, or untalented, or unlovable. Well, she made the point that we are not to say those things to ourselves, either. We are God's precious children. He is the radiant child, holding out his little arms to embrace us with tender love. He is also a loving Father, loving us now, as we are. He became man so that we could become holy, and longs to heal our deepest wounds.

St. Augustine, commenting on the Gospel of John, wrote that "Your light is your God; He is your dawn, for He will come to you when the night of time is over..."

You are invited to attend the Epiphany concert this Sunday at 4pm at the Cathedral. May the music bring you joy as we continue celebrating the birth of Christ!


