We are looking forward to seeing Fr. Daniel Maurer, CJD, the pastor of our parish in Vladivostok, soon. He will be in St. Joseph July 21 and 22. Please join us in Ruggle Hall for a presentation by Father at 6:30pm on Tuesday, July 22. This weekend we are in Prosper, Texas, at St. Martin de Porres parish.

News from Dom Marii, our Russian convent: there was a retreat held by a local non-denominational Christian church on June 6-8. Then, on July 14-29, the same church has a summer gathering for children and then one for teens. What a blessing! The Russian Catholic young adult group had a picnic there a few weekends ago, and this coming weekend, the Catholic university student group will enjoy a picnic and swimming. The weather has been unusually hot, but it's an actual summer this year in Vladivostok! The drainage that is so needed around our convent has been delayed once again, as our faithful foreman is ill. Please pray for his full recovery.

We are especially grateful for the resources that have been shared with us lately that we will be bringing to Russia—a Bible study program for healing after sexual abuse, "Finding You", a Bible study program for healing after abortion called "Save One", and soon a program called "Living Waters".
