Message from Father Hansen . . . I write this on the Memorial of St. Benedict, July 7th. It was a great privilege to visit the town St. Benedict (and his twin sister, St. Scholastica) was born in (Norcia, Italy). Catholic piety over the years has led to sacramentals being used to help faithful grow in holiness and virtue. The Catechism says this about sacraments: *1677 Sacramentals are sacred signs instituted by the Church. They prepare men to receive the fruit of the sacraments and sanctify different circumstances of life. 1670 Sacramentals do not confer the grace of the Holy Spirit in the way that the sacraments do, but by the Church's prayer, they prepare us to receive grace and dispose us to cooperate with it. "For well-disposed members of the faithful, the liturgy of the sacraments and sacramentals sanctifies almost every event of their lives with the divine grace which flows from the Paschal mystery of the Passion, Death, and Resurrection of Christ. From this source all sacraments and sacramentals draw their power. There is scarcely any proper use of material things which cannot be thus directed toward the sanctification of men and the praise of God."*

One of the four most recommended sacramentals is the St. Benedict Medal. Two others include the Miraculous Medal and the crucifix. The fourth is the Brown Scapular. This coming Tuesday we celebrate the Memorial of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. One Saint says this about the Brown Scapular of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel "Wear on your breast the holy scapular of Carmel. There are many excellent Marian devotions, but few are so deep—rooted among the faithful, and have received so many blessings from the Popes. Besides, how maternal this sabbatine privilege is!" We have about 50 Scapulars in the sacristy; hesitate not to ask Fr. Becker or myself to install you in the Fraternity of the Scapular or to bless one for you (if you've already been installed). I'm sure Blessings of St. Joseph will have a good supply of all four of these Sacramentals! Hesitate not to use them all!
