#### A Message from Mother M. Stella, CJD . . .

Thank you to everyone who helped us prepare for our open house and blessing of our new altar and icon of Our Lady of Fatima! It was such a gift to us that many of you were able to come for this beautiful event.

We are so grateful for our wonderfully restored Cathedral Convent! May it be a place of prayer, retreat and formation of new sisters for many years to come. We love being here, and it is a true home.

An unexpected event happened in our community this spring. Sr. Catherine discerned a call to join an order of Franciscan sisters in Texas and became a novice there at the end of April.

Now that there are three of us, it is clear that we need some extended time together. Two of us have residency permits in Russia, which require us to not be out of Russia for more than six months per year. We have been trading places approximately every six months. This year, in addition to usual permit deadlines, I need to renew my registration in February. We have decided to stay in Russia for the entire calendar year, until next summer. Sr. Joanna is deferring her last year at Benedictine by a year so she can be with us in Russia.

We are going to miss you this year! We are trusting in the Lord that he will bless our community soon with more sisters. We will continue praying for you at evening prayer each day, and will send regular updates, too. Your prayers and encouragement mean so much.

Sr. Faustina is going to visit Mother Julia on the way to Vladivostok, departing July 24. Sr. Joanna and I are going to visit family on the way to Russia, most likely departing August 4.

God is so faithful, and we have experienced so much of his mercy and love through you. Please pray for us, and we look forward to seeing you when we return.
