#### Message from Father Stephen Hansen

I write from the Institute for Catholic Liberal Education conference in Lincoln, Nebraska, on Thursday. This morning on a break I had the chance to go to Confession (I try my best to go every week). The priest spoke of the hope that is always present in Confession. In this year of Hope, it might be a good thing to think of that when we go to Confession! This year's theme for the 5<sup>th</sup> World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, which we will celebrate next Sunday, July 27<sup>th</sup>, is "Blessed are those who have not lost hope." (cf. Sir 14:2)

This can be found in the February 4<sup>th</sup> "Communique" released (see below) from Pope Francis. Pope Leo recently said: "hope is a constant source of joy, whatever our age... when that hope has also been tempered by fire over the course of a long life, it proves a source of deep happiness."

I mentioned at one Mass last weekend that this year the World Day is also my birthday. I ask a favor of you for my birthday, to visit a grandparent or elderly person and look for hope that comes from their tempered life. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you find a new source of happiness because of your visit!

Happy Grandparents and Elderly Day to you beautiful older people! May your gifts never be taken for granted, and may you share them all the days of your life!

Press Communiqué from the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life: Theme of the Fifth World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, 04.02.2025

The Holy Father has chosen the theme of the Fifth World Day of Grandparents and the Elderly, to be held this year on Sunday 27 July: "Blessed are those who have not lost hope" (cf. Sir 14:2).

These words, taken from the Book of Sirach, express the blessedness of the elderly and indicate hope placed in the Lord as the way to a Christian and reconciled old age.

In the Jubilee year, the Day, established by Pope Francis in 2021, is intended to be an opportunity to reflect on how the presence of grandparents and the elderly can become a sign of hope in every family and church community.

The Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life renews to everyone Pope Francis' invitation to celebrate the Day in every diocese, and to dedicate the celebrations of Sunday 27 July to the elderly, promoting visits and opportunities for encounters between the generations.
