Message from Father Hansen ...

This last Tuesday, July 16th, the Collaborative Steering Committee met in its second comprehensive meeting. I'm grateful to the good number of parishioners who are again volunteering their talent to contribute to the recommendations to Bishop Johnston regarding the Catholic schools in St. Joseph. Particularly I'm grateful to Becky Evans, the principal here at Cathedral, and her husband Michael, who teaches at Bishop LeBlond High School. Both are dedicated to education and Becky is working om her PhD in organizational change at Baylor University.

When I came to Cathedral last summer, the Bishop met with all the priests and the school office staff. The priests were all supportive of changes to make the schools work together for the long run. Dr. Peters, the superintendent of schools, on Tuesday, said he had talked to the Bishop and confirmed that he wants serious consideration of a citywide academy that would be of the classical method of education. I'm not aware as much as I would like to be about this method; however the more I learn the more I like it. I really believe this method, which includes grammar, logic, and rhetoric from K through grade 12, would be a return to time tested way of helping our children think and defend the divine law and the goodness of God along with all the pillars of education (math, science..).

You'll have a chance to watch videos and learn more about this consideration down the road. As I recall the recommendation(s) won't be given to Bishop Johnston until next spring. Please pray for Becky, Michael, and all who are working on the Committee. I'm proud of all of them and thankful they would share their talents!
