Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . .

Next weekend will be the seminarians' last here for the summer, and Fr. Armentrout will be back. What a fast summer. This week I also turned 61! A friend texted me: "Happy birthday, Father. Is it just me or do birthdays seem to make us older?" I replied: "Thanks!!!! Yes, older, but trying to be young of heart (not so successful)..."

One way we remain young of heart is through children. It's awesome to think the amazing teachers will be back next week and the students on August 16th. One day this week, I met Mrs. Supple between the rectory and the Cathedral. As we visited, a little family walked up, of Mexican descent, for a kindergarten interview. Mrs. Supple was, of course, amazingly compassionate. Later that evening, I saw Fr. Jonathan Davis from St. Patrick's. He had helped the people (along with Kent and Lauren from our school) complete the MOScholars application. Father then shared that the grandpa, who was with them, was a descendent of the Martyrs of Mexico during the Cristero War. In fact, he has the same last name as one of the martyrs. Father also told me that the mother of the children cried when she learned the application was complete, they were accepted, and now the kindergartener only needed an interview with Mrs. Supple.
