Let God's greatest evangelist, Mary, help lead you to the fullness of Truth - *His Body*, *Blood*, *Soul and Divinity*

Message from Father Stephen Hansen... Today we celebrate the 18th Sunday in Ordinary Time. In the summer months, and between Christmas Season and the beginning of Lent, Ordinary Time can be a time of imagining the thirty years of hidden "ordinary" life of Jesus - maybe his visiting his family as we often do on trips in the summer; maybe traveling on excursions to see nature or to support a distant relative or friend of Mary and Joseph; or maybe enjoying the demands of a good hike.

It can be in the "ordinary" times of our lives that Jesus can speak to us, call us, in extraordinary ways. Often times at Sunday Mass or when we're spiritually reading our Bible or a spiritual book, or when meditating on something we've read, we feel dry. We can be tempted to give up. Even as we live, the routine of our work and daily schedule can seem, dare I say, pointless. We can want to give up. We try harder to put more love in our prayer and work. Do our work better. The same feeling happens. Then, when we least expect it, there is a light; God speaks to our heart. Reflecting on this, and the thirty years of Jesus' life without his preaching or miracles, can push us on to know the dignity and nobility of ordinary life lived out of love for God.

Relating this to prayer in general, I'd like to share a quote of St. Josemaria Escriva, whose relic is in the back of the Cathedral: You have told me sometimes that you are like a clock out of order, which strikes at the wrong moment: you feel cold, dry and arid at the time of your prayer, and on the other hand, when it is least to be expected, in the street, in the midst of your daily activities, in the bustle and hubbub of the city, or in the concentrated calm of your professional work, you find yourself praying... At the wrong moment? Possibly; but don't waste those chimes of your clock. The Spirit breathes where he will. ~ The Way no. 110

Let's enjoy these summer days, pray, and work too, and expect of the Lord to speak to us when we need it, as we need it, and with many surprises (as Pope Francis would say "God's a God of surprises").
