**Father Armentrout’s message . . .** Dear Parishioners of the Cathedral of St. Joseph,

My name is Fr. Armentrout and I am very excited to be moving back to the Cathedral and St. Mary’s to begin my first assignment as a priest of this diocese! Fr. Hansen thought it might be nice if I included a brief biography in the bulletin as a way to introduce myself.

I grew up in small town Salisbury, Missouri, where I attended St. Joseph Grade School and Salisbury High School. I have two older sisters and a younger brother. The first time I recall wanting to serve God as a priest was in second grade - my mother had taken me to the first Mass of a priest. Shortly after, another priest started teaching us all religion in the catholic school. Attending Mass offered 5 times a week by this priest and having him teach me three days a week was very influential! In High School, I was uncertain if I was called to the priesthood - but continued coming to Mass at least twice a week. By the end of my senior year of high school, I decided to accept a football scholarship to Benedictine College. During that year at BC, I made many lifelong friends - but also returned to a more frequent reception of the sacraments and a more routine life of prayer than a public school offered. During the course of that year, I discerned to enter the seminary.

I spent three years at St. Gregory the Great seminary in Seward, Nebraska (where I joined Fr. King) and graduated with a degree in the Liberal Arts and Philosophy. Upon completion of my time in Nebraska, I moved to Kenrick Glennon Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri, where I received an STB and a Masters in Divinity. But perhaps the greatest part of seminary was not the academic side (although I enjoyed that). Rather, spending the time with other men who were discerning the same vocation as me fostered many close friendships. On top of this, striving to make a daily Holy Hour in front of the Blessed Sacrament and immersing myself in the liturgy made a real connection between the Truth I encountered in the classroom, my daily life, and the chapel.

I look forward to serving as your new parochial vicar! (If I look familiar to you, it is because I was here as a seminarian two summers ago)! Another interesting fact, 80 years ago, my great-great uncle - Fr. William Schumann was ordained a priest for the diocese of St. Joseph. He was ordained in this Cathedral and then was stationed here for the first few years of his priesthood. I am excited to follow in his footsteps and the footsteps of so many priests and religious.

In addition to serving at St. Mary’s and the Cathedral, I will be the chaplain for Missouri Western State University. I will also be teaching some of the religion classes at the Cathedral school.
