## A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

After the Easter Season and a good number of Solemnities after, we are finally wearing green vestments and today is the 14<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. I recall, when in seminary, the Dean of Students would say, "I like Ordinary Time, it's good to be in a normal routine at times, and it helps me appreciate the special Times (Advent... Easter)."

When we can take our ordinary routines to Mass on Sunday, something happens and, in a way, everything "ordinary" takes on new meaning. To even contemplate that Jesus himself lived an ordinary life for 30 years is quite outstanding. I have shared with some of you that when I was in Medjugorje, it was impressive for me to see the seer (visionary) wait on tables for breakfast and lunch. These two examples can lead us to recall how important our ordinary lives are, no matter if we are the CEO or a laborer. What really matters is that we do our work well, and offer it to God as prayer.

Two nice quotes from St. Josemaria (whose relic is in the back of the Cathedral) relate to this, too.

"Before God, no occupation is in itself great or small. Everything gains the value of the Love with which it is done." ~ Furrow 487

"You say it helps you a lot to wonder how many businessmen have become saints since the time of the early Christians. And you want to show that it is also possible today... —The Lord will not abandon you in that effort." ~ Furrow 490
