Message From Father Hansen

Happy Father's Day, dads!!!!! In the first letter of St. John we read: "See what love the Father has for us, that He has called us sons of God, and so we are! We are truly children of God" (1 Jn 3:1-2). Of course, we are also sons of our dads; in my case, Eugene Walter Hansen. When I visit my siblings on July 16th (I'll be in Racine, WI, for three full days), at some point I'll stop by the cemetery and pray at my dad's tomb (and my mom's next to his). Why? We venerate our dads — and we have Father's Day to prove it. This year, whether we have or had a good relationship with our fathers or not. Whether we even knew them or not. Let's thank God the Father (and St. Joseph) for them! We have life itself because of them and our moms. Let's pray for them, living or deceased, and forgive them, too!

When I was in seminary in St. Louis in a pastoral counseling class, I was frankly shocked with a video interview we watched of a young woman meeting her father for the first time, after he had violated her years earlier. The young woman spoke of the desire she had to forgive – and, yes, keep good boundaries with the help of a counselor - and have her dad back in her life.

Most of us have nothing but gratitude for our fathers, but not all. However, no matter what, we all have the same Father God, who sent his only begotten Son, who as we celebrated last week, stays with us in the Tabernacle! He's always there for you, for me. As we begin the parish year of revival for the Eucharist, let's visit Jesus in the Tabernacle, and connect with our Father God through Him! Let's also join our father, Bishop Johnston, on July 1st for the Blessing of the Convent after the 4pm Mass. There will be a cookout after! Please mark your calendar.





erchant mariners, fishermen, port workers, and others working in the maritime industries have special pastoral needs to remain connected with their faith. For over a century, Apostleship of the Sea (AOS) has served merchant sailors around the world by providing sacraments and spiritual renewal through port chaplaincies, as well as hospitality, recreational opportunities, and communication with loved ones at home.

In 2013, Apostleship of the Sea of the United States of America developed Stella Maris, the only smartphone app for Catholic merchant sailors. As technology and code systems advanced, the original app became obsolete. In 2022, AOS-USA, using a grant from the Catholic Communication Campaign, rebuilt the app to work on iOS and Android phones. The updated app keeps Catholic seafarers close to their faith by including a directory of AOS chaplains across the United States and around the world, daily prayers and reflections, a feature that allows sailors to submit their own prayer requests, news, and a cruise ship feature that lets cruise passengers know which ships have Catholic priests on board.


