*Since **Father Hansen** will be celebrating all the weekend Masses for **Cathedral** and **St. Mary Church** this summer, the time for Confessions before weekend Masses may be shortened.

The **MO Scholars K-12 Scholarships Program** provides financial assistance to new families wishing to send their children to Catholic Schools. Families who qualify will be able to apply for a scholarship to attend one of our Catholic Schools in St. Joseph, and donors will be able to receive special tax credits for their donations.

This new law provides state tax credits for contributions to Educational Assistance Organizations (EAOs). The Diocese of Kansas city's Bright Futures Fund has been designated as an EAO.

Incoming kindergarteners and first graders, who meet the income threshold or have an Individual Education Plan, are eligible to receive scholarships. Families with children in other grades must have been enrolled in a public or charter school. Current Catholic school families in grades 2-12 are not eligible to participate.

Father Stephen Hansen's Message . . . Today we celebrate Corpus Christi – The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ! The Catechism of the Catholic Church says this about the Body and Blood of Christ: **1374** The mode of Christ's presence under the Eucharistic species is unique. It raises the Eucharist above all the sacraments as "the perfection of the spiritual life and the end to which all the sacraments tend." In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist "the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, *the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially* contained." "This presence is called 'real'—by which is not intended to exclude the other types of presence as if they could not be 'real' too, but because it is presence in the fullest sense: that is to say, it is a *substantial* presence by which Christ, God and man, makes himself wholly and entirely present."

This fullest sense points us, I hope, to think that more is expected of us as we receive Jesus in this way. Not all Christians believe the same as we do and receive in this way.

On another topic, Fr. Charles Rowe recently wrote to the clergy of the Diocese: "The pending U.S. Supreme Court decision on the Dobbs case and its potential to overturn Roe v. Wade has brought the issue of care for mothers and their unborn children into the spotlight. . ." And I wrote recently, "As we move forward after hearing about the Supreme Court's decision, let us pray that the truth of life will prevail. Let us also begin now, at Cathedral of St. Joseph and St. Mary's, to ask *how can we serve life?* Parish based ministries can do a lot with the support of the Diocese and our friends. Let our love for life lead us to assisting others. . . in need regarding life, in new, and maybe old with orphanages, ways!

Finally, again, please keep in your prayer the use of the new Educational Savings Accounts (MO Scholars) and <https://www.brightfuturesfund.org/moscholars.html>. This "game changer" for the State of Missouri and private schools, including the schools in the Diocese of Kansas City – St. Joseph, will have a great impact on availability of a Catholic Education to many in the future. If you know of anyone who is not going to Catholic Schools because of the cost, please have them contact me through the parish office or at shansen@cathedralsj.org.

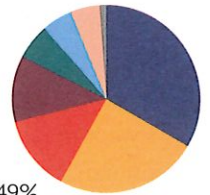

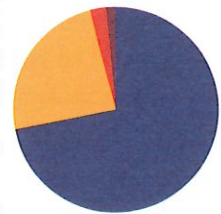
