#### A Message from Fr. Hansen

Happy Ascension!

We gather this week on Sunday, reflecting on the Ascension of the Lord, and next week for Pentecost! And, after that, back to Ordinary Time again until Advent, wow...

Last week in my homily for the 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter, I spoke of the peace that comes from knowing the truth. I quote Pope Leo and the good number of times he spoke of peace in his address on the day of his election. Also, of course, the words of our Lord from the Gospel: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you."

In the 15<sup>th</sup> Chapter of the Acts of the Apostoles from last week, we read: "The apostles and elders, in agreement with the whole church, decided to choose representatives and to send them to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas." You may recall me pointing out that the first two groups referred to the Apostles and Priests. The third group spoke of "the whole church". After I reflected on that I thought, oh, that's what Pope Francis meant when he spoke of how we needed a more synodal Church. Then I recalled Pope Leo's first address from the balcony of St. Peter. On May 8<sup>th</sup> he said: "We can still hear the faint yet ever courageous voice of Pope Francis as he blessed Rome, the Pope who blessed Rome, who gave his blessing to the world, the whole world, on the morning of Easter. Allow me to extend that same blessing: God loves us, God loves you all, and evil will not prevail! All of us are in God's hands. So, let us move forward, without fear, together, hand in hand with God and with one another! We are followers of Christ. Christ goes before us. The world needs his light. Humanity needs him as the bridge that can lead us to God and his love. Help us, one and all, to build bridges through dialogue and encounter, joining together as one people, always at peace. Thank you, Pope Francis!"

His references to moving forward "without fear, together, hand in hand with God and with one another" could spur us on to listen more, dialogue more, speak differently... This could help us build bridges and advance peace in ways we couldn't if we just hunkered down in the truths we know... May the "whole church" in St. Joseph heed these words of Pope Leo - which remind us of Pope Francis – and maybe the words of St. Josemaria (whose relic is in the Cathedral): "A saying of a soul of prayer: in intentions, may Jesus be our aim; in affections, our Love; in conversation, our theme; in actions, our model." ~ The Way 271
