**Father Hansen's Message . . .**

This Sunday we're wearing green vestments on a Sunday for the first time since before Lent; it's the 12<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time. Last week in my Bulletin article I wrote:

*"A parishioner wrote me recently: "I was just in reflection and wanted to say how appreciative I am of how you mention often about the work people do and that it is important (how Jesus and Joseph both labored) - no matter how challenging, stressful or even mundane it may be. ..."*

*If I were to give credit to others for my speaking about the great dignity of ordinary life and work, it would have to go to St. Josemaria Escriva. His feast day is coming up, June 26<sup>th</sup>, and we'll have a 6pm Mass and hang a print of him and first-class relic in the back of the Cathedral.*

Please consider coming to Mass on Friday morning or evening (9am and 6pm – program for the 6pm Mass is included in the email containing the Bulletin) and particularly learn about St. Josemaria's love for our Lady (the theme of my homily). Pope St. John Paul II said this about this Saint (October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2002): "St Josemaria was chosen by the Lord to announce the universal call to holiness and to point out that daily life and ordinary activities are a path to holiness. One could say that he was the saint of ordinary life."

Let us try to see God's hand in our ordinary life as we move more fully into Ordinary Time.

As many of you know Fr. Jason Becker begins his new assignment on July 1<sup>st</sup> (and Fr. Timothy Leete joins us at the Cathedral and at St. Mary's). Given the social distancing and inability to have a potluck or buffet of any kind, Fr. Becker will go to the outside classroom at the Cathedral and to the outside gathering space at St. Mary's (by the statue of Our Lady) after the Masses he has on the next two weekends. He'll also be at a reception available to all after the 3pm Marian Concert at the Cathedral on Sunday, June 28<sup>th</sup>. Please thank Father and hesitate not to bring a card (baskets will be available). Please pray for him and Fr. Leete in their transitions. Fr. Becker has the following Masses this weekend:

St. Mary's 5:30pm on Saturday and 8:30am, 10am, and 11:30am Sunday at the Cathedral. Next weekend (June 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>) he has: 4pm at Cathedral on Saturday and 8am and 10am at St. Mary's on Sunday.
