Father Benjamin Armentrout's Message... I'm happy to be writing this bulletin article from Washington D.C.! It is hard to believe that June is coming to an end and July is about to begin! I am wrapping up my first set of examinations for the first half of this summer's Canon Law Program and look forward to returning to St. Joseph in just over a month after my July classes.

This past week, we had a major seasonal marker on the annual calendar. The Summer Solstice marks the longest day of the year and the shortest night. From this point on, each day will become increasingly shorter until the Winter solstice. Almost concurrent with this annual marker is the liturgical feast of the nativity of St. John the Baptist- this year the feast landed on Thursday, June 23. It is an interesting historical fact that for centuries Christians have commemorated this great feast around the time of the longest day of the year! Our Lord himself said of John that "he was a burning and shining light: and you were willing for a time to rejoice in his light. But I have a greater testimony than that of John..." (John 5:35-36). We recall that John was like a torch to prepare the world for the coming of the *True Light* of the world (John 8:12). But once the sun begins to shine, a torch is no longer needed for vision. John the Baptist spent his whole life as the precursor and friend of our Lord whose only goal was to point him out (John 1:29). This time of the year, as we continue to enjoy these long summer days, let it stand as a reminder for us of this great Saint and his mission to make our Lord known. Let it inspire us to lead others to Christ by the way we live our lives. . . . -Fr. Armentrout
