## A Message from Father Stephen Hansen . . .

Happy Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul!!!

Pope Benedict XVI once said: "Christian tradition has always considered Saint Peter and Saint Paul to be inseparable: indeed, together, they represent the whole Gospel of Christ." Many of us have heard, too, that St. Peter was the apostle to the circumcised, the chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and St. Paul as apostle to the Gentiles. We celebrate today these two great apostles who pushed forth the beginnings of the Church. The Saints are important to all of us. Pope Leo ordained men priests on Friday, and said: "Remember that the Church, in the two thousand years of her history, has had – and today continues to have – wonderful examples of priestly holiness. From the earliest communities on, the Church has raised up priests who have been martyrs, tireless apostles, missionaries, and champions of charity. Cherish this treasure: learn their stories, study their lives and work, imitate their virtues, be inspired by their zeal, and invoke their intercession often and insistently!" Peter and Paul were two of those!!

One lesson I learned from St. Peter pushed me right to the seminary. 27 years ago, when I was discerning the priesthood I thought, based on some things a friend shared, I was too gullible and naïve to be a priest. In the confessional in Medjugorje on June 27<sup>th</sup>, 1998, after sharing that, the priest said, "what was Peter's name before Peter?" I knew and responded "Simon." "What does Simon mean?" he asked. He then shared, "blown by the wind, gullible; if God built the Church on a guy who was the most gullible of the apostles, then He can surely make you a priest." I've never forgotten those words. We can all be gullible at times, and God can strengthen us. We can all deny Christ and his Church as Peter did, and God still uses us. We can all even speak harshly of the Church and Her leaders, as did Paul when he aided the death of St. Stephen.

In the apostles Peter and Paul, we all can find hope to advance Christ's kingdom here in St. Joseph and wherever we're sent. Why? Because it is Christ who works in us, and Mary & Joseph, help us follow Him!

Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us!

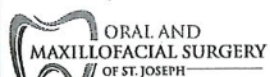
