I write you on Friday, May 31st, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. You'll receive this on Sunday, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (the Body of Christ).

As we continue our journey in the years of Eucharistic Revival, I'm reminded of an interpretation of the Visitation by a popular Christian artist, Danielle Rose (available on "Formed").
