### A Message from Father Stephen Hansen

I write you on Friday, May 31<sup>st</sup>, the Feast of the Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary. You'll receive this on Sunday, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi (the Body of Christ).

As we continue our journey in the years of Eucharistic Revival, I'm reminded of an interpretation of the Visitation by a popular Christian artist, Danielle Rose (available on "Formed"). She described, in one of her songs, the first Adoration of Jesus when John leapt in his mother's womb at the Visitation. Mary, pregnant with Jesus, approached Elizabeth, pregnant with John, and John "leapt."

Corpus Christi is about Adoration and even taking Jesus through the public streets allowing all to Adore!
