Dear Parishioners of the Cathedral Parish of St. Joseph,

Thank you for the warm welcome to the Cathedral of St. Joseph! I am grateful that I am able to spend the summer at this parish which is so important for our diocese and me personally! Before the dioceses of Kansas City and St. Joseph were merged in the 1950s my great uncle (Fr. William Schumann) was ordained in this cathedral as a priest and served here as an associate for two years. I also had two great aunts who served in the convent. And, as I am sure you have heard, the diocese intends to have the Transitional Diaconate ordinations here next May. I am grateful that this will be the parish I will lay down on the floor, like my family before me, asking for the intercession of the saints so that I might be a holy minister of God. So I am very grateful that I will be here in the parish for this summer to prepare for the Sacrament of Holy Orders.

Over my past five years in the seminary I have often times been asked, “Why do you want to be a priest?” When I was in Second Grade, I went to the first Mass of a newly ordained priest. Watching him celebrate Mass for the first time, I knew that I would like to do the same someday. On our way home I asked my mother a few questions. “When am I going to be a priest?” And, “where will my first parish be?” That school year as I prepared to receive the sacraments, my home parish was blessed with a new pastor who started teaching all of the religion classes from second to eighth grade. As I came to understand the Church, Sacraments, and know Our Lord through personal prayer each day, the desire to be a priest only increased. After a year at Benedictine College, I applied for Seminary. Now that there is much worry and public scandal in the church, I am able to look back to these past events and thank God that I could see his guiding providence and paternal care in all of these moments. He gave me a loving family, a nice education, many good friends, a prayerful parish priest, and now thanks to the many generous people of the diocese, he has provided me an excellent seminary formation.

I am grateful that I can spend the summer here before my ordination. I look forward to getting to know you better through the course of the next month and a half before returning to Kenrick in St. Louis. Feel free to talk to me any time after Mass or as you see me around the parish. Please continue to keep Jared, Garrett, our other two classmates (Elvis and Angel), and me in your prayers as we prepare for Holy Orders. Know of my prayers for you.
