### "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him, says the Lord." (John 6:57)

Father Hansen's Message... Today we celebrate Corpus Christi. In some places it is celebrated on Thursday. St. Josemaria, whose relic is near the confessional in the Cathedral, wrote this in a homily on this feast: "The miracle of the holy Eucharist is being continually renewed and it has all Jesus' personal traits. Perfect God and perfect man, Lord of heaven and earth, he offers himself to us as nourishment in the most natural and ordinary way. Love has been awaiting us for almost two thousand years. That's a long time and yet it's not, for when you are in love time flies."

It was a joy to be at Fr. Garrett King's first Mass of thanksgiving here at the Cathedral. On Monday, I had the opportunity to attend Fr. Ben Armentrout's second Mass of thanksgiving at the Convent in Gower. He wore a vestment made from his mother's wedding dress. It was touching to see him give Communion to his mom and dad with that vestment. I wasn't able to see Fr. King give Communion to his parents (I was distributing Communion on the other side of the church) but I bet the sentiments were the same.

What a joy to be a priest. If you heard Bishop Johnston's homily for the Ordination, you could draw that it is great to be a "jackass" (donkey) carrying our Lord to people, especially in Holy Communion. The jackass is humble and steady. Let us never take the Eucharist for granted. Let us ask for an increase in faith in what the Eucharist can do in our ordinary lives! Let us think of those away from the Eucharist, and pray for them when we come to Mass, with great confidence. Let us humbly try to bring them back to Communion. Communion with Jesus in the Eucharist and with their brothers and sisters. You know that this is the first weekend the dispensation from attending Mass due to Covid-19 is no longer in effect. Essentially, we are now in serious sin if we miss Mass on Sundays (Saturday vigil or Sunday) and Holy Days of Obligation. We should be concerned about the souls of those not here today. On a positive note, what a joy it has been to see people coming back steadily, especially after they've been OK'd by their doctors, maybe having received the Vaccine. The Eucharist is something we need; to serve and love like Jesus did! To serve and love in good times and bad, in sickness and health!
