A Message from Deacon Joshua Fultz

*Breath of God, Breath of Life, breathe into me again. **

I just recently finished reading a new book by John Eldredge titled *Experience. Jesus. Really.* It is a beautiful book about building and experiencing a true relationship with our Lord. In one of the chapters, he discusses the Breath of God, and this chapter came to mind when I was looking over the readings for Pentecost.

The Breath of God is the Breath of Life. God gives Adam life by “breathing into his nostrils.” In book of Ezekiel, we read of God’s Breath being a re-creation in his vision of God breathing life into the valley of dry bones and bringing them back to life. The same is true for us. The Breath of God was there at our creation, and it can be for each one of us a “re-creation.” We see this echoed when Jesus appears to the Apostles after his resurrection and breathes on them and says, “Receive the Holy Spirit.”

Fans of the “Narnia” series might recall the scene when the Great Lion Aslan breathes new life into the hundreds of Narnian creatures that had been turned into stone. This is what we see in Pentecost. The Breath of God filling the room and bringing new life to the Apostles and Mary and imbuing them with the fire and the gifts they will need to carry out the work of spreading the Gospel message of Jesus Christ.

Each one of us received these same gifts in our baptism and confirmation. The question becomes, are we embracing them and using them? Are we filled with the fiery desire to bring that Gospel message into today’s world? Do you want to be? Are you brave enough to ask for the Breath of God, the Breath of Life, to come and re-create you and fill you with new life? If you have the courage, join me in praying this simple prayer from John Eldredge:

*Breath of God, Breath of Life, breathe into me again.
Breath of God, Breath of Life, breathe into me again.
Breathe into my heart and soul, my mind and strength.
Breath of God, Breath of Life, breathe Hope into me.
Breathe Love into me.
Breathe Faith into me.
Breath of God, Breath of Life, breathe into me again.
