Sunday we'll celebrate Pentecost with you; I'll be in Rome, hopefully with the Holy Father, and then be present for his Angelus address! Next Monday and Tuesday we'll visit Naples, Pompeii, and Monte Cassino (where Sts. Benedict and Scholastica are buried)! Wednesday I begin my trip back to St. Joseph, and the seminarians (including Jared) continue in Rome, then go to Spain, returning to the States on July 1<sup>st</sup>.
