# A message from Mother M. Stella Whittier, CJD (writing from Vladivostok, Russia)

Now that we have reached the fifth Sunday of Lent, we enter upon our last week before Holy Week. Regardless of how faithful you have been to your Lenten resolutions so far, this is a specially graced time to turn to the Lord, to acknowledge your complete dependence on Him and to read a little of the Bible each day, especially the Gospels, as Jesus approaches Jerusalem.

As a community, we have been reading *He Leadeth Me*, by Servant of God Fr. Walter J. Ciszek, SJ, this Lent. I cannot recommend this book highly enough, the fruit of 23 years of spiritual reflection in Soviet Russia, mostly in prison and labor camps. Each chapter contains more insights of how he came to completely rely on the Lord and learned to join himself to God's will in every moment. The following prayer is based on his spirituality. I invite you to pray this each day until Easter:

#### Prayer of Surrender

Lord, Jesus Christ, I ask the grace to accept the sadness in my heart, as your will for me, in this moment. I offer it up, in union with your sufferings, for those who are in deepest need of your redeeming grace. I surrender myself to your Father's will and I ask you to help me to move on to the next task that you have set for me.

Spirit of Christ, help me to enter into a deeper union with you. Lead me away from dwelling on the hurt I feel:

to thoughts of charity for those who need my love,

to thoughts of compassion for those who need my care, and

to thoughts of giving to those who need my help.

As I give myself to you, help me to provide for the salvation of those who come to me in need,

May I find my healing in this giving.

May I always accept God's will.

May I find my true self by living for others in a spirit of sacrifice and suffering.

May I die more fully to myself, and live more fully in you.

As I seek to surrender to the Father's will, may I come to trust that he will do everything for me. Amen.
