Father Hansen's Message . . .

I write this on Friday – March 4th – before meeting with some young men from a nearby school that want to talk about Charles Untz. This Sunday, March 6th, would be Charles' birthday. You can learn about Charles at: <http://www.myladysknight.org/>

As you parishioners know, I talk about Charles often, but why? Why, because he's an example we can follow, a possible Saint who can help us, and a gutsy young man who desired the greatest good, to be with God as a Saint!

How an example? He prayed regularly, he mortified his flesh, and he was quick to forgive. He prayed, fasted, and was merciful. His example of prayer was by praying the Rosary daily, and praying the Liturgy of the Hours of the Church. He obeyed his parents the first time he was asked. When he was "picked on" by someone, he was the first to assist the boy at the next opportunity.

Let's ask for Charles' help with Lent. He can direct us to the best of things, the real purpose of Lent: to convert and be with God forever in heaven!
