Go to the Cathedral website at cathedralsj.org, look under **MASS TIMES**, see link **CLICK HERE** which will take you directly to <https://www.facebook.com/pg/CathedralStJoseph/videos/>, which is the Cathedral Videos Page. If you scroll down, you will see a section that has all of the videos in small squares. The most recent video will be in the upper left hand corner in the first spot. When we go live, the video will be in this first spot and it will have a red badge that says **LIVE** on it. Click on the video and it will automatically come up and begin to play.
