Message from Father Hansen... Happy Mother's Day, mothers! Today we'll honor mothers at the end of Mass with a Blessing. We'll of course pray for our mothers who are deceased and those who may be in any bad predicaments or who are away. What a great gift our mothers are. What a great vocation to be a mother. This in a special way can be confirmed in the words of our Lord in John 19:27 when he said to St. John the Evangelist, "behold your mother." And when he said "behold your son" to Mary.

Mary has been a mother to all Christians ever since whether or not they know it. So many times, I hear people tell me Mary brought me back to Jesus and the sacraments. Mary brought me back to church. Mary has supernaturally appeared in a variety of places around the world, including (you know I've mentioned often) 14 miles northeast of Green Bay, Wisconsin. Her first apparition ever was to St. James in about the year 44. She actually bilocated (was in two places at once). Here is one explanation of the apparition: Tradition says that in the early days of the Church, Saint James the Greater was spreading the Gospel in Spain, but making very little progress. He was dejected and questioning his mission. About 44, the Virgin Mary, who was still living in Jerusalem at the time, bi-located and appeared to him in a vision to boost his morale. In it, she was atop a column or pillar, which was being carried by angels. That pillar is believed to be the same one venerated in Zaragoza, Spain today. Miraculous healings reported at the scene. As we honor and venerate our mothers today, and as we pray for our deceased mothers, let us turn with confidence to the mother who will help us stay close to our Savior, Jesus Christ.
