#### Father Hansen's message . . .

On this Sunday of Easter, we are in the midst of the first novena, if you will, the nine days between the Ascension and Pentecost. We celebrate Ascension on Sunday in many places (including our Diocese) whereas in some place it is still celebrated 40 days after Easter, this past Thursday.

In the beginning of the school year, the votive Mass of The Holy Spirit is often used. This past week we celebrated the end of not only a school year but school years with the 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Graduation. What a joyous occasion. It is difficult in these times to raise children; I am proud of the effort our parents, teachers, and administrators put in.
