Message From Deacon Benjamin Fenlon

Dear Cathedral Community,

This weekend, we have had the grace of a priestly Ordination to the diocese. Fr. Mark Famuliner is from Carrollton, Missouri. Thanks to his experience giving counselling and working in prison ministry, he understands the *human* aspect of the spiritual life very well. Remember that *human* aspect!


