Message From Deacon Benjamin Fenlon

Dear Cathedral Community,

This weekend, we have had the grace of a priestly Ordination to the diocese. Fr. Mark Famuliner is from Carrollton, Missouri. Thanks to his experience giving counselling and working in prison ministry, he understands the *human* aspect of the spiritual life very well. Remember that *human* aspect!

God wants to make us saints – but He wants to make **us** saints! That means, he does not want us to be someone else. He accepts us with our scars and our history, and He transforms those into a springboard to become better people – saints!
