Father Hansen's message . . . Please keep in your prayers the use of the new Educational Savings Accounts and https://www.brightfuturesfund.org/moscholars.html. This "game changer" for the State of Missouri and private schools, including the schools in the Diocese of Kansas City – St. Joseph, will have a great impact on availability of a Catholic Education to many in the future. If you know of anyone who is not going to Catholic Schools because of the cost, please have them contact me through the parish office or at shansen@cathedralsj.org. I have a team of parishioners who've offered to help identify and help such families. As I wrote before, the average cost of student tuition in Catholic Schools is \$5,700 per year. The ESA will provide up to \$6,375 for tuition, fees, and tutors for each child approved. In the first year we (the Diocese) are guaranteed \$2.5 million in tuition payments for the 2022/2023 school year. The first funds will be available beginning July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022!

The MO Scholars K-12 Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to new families wishing to send their children to Catholic schools. Families who qualify will be able to apply for a scholarship to attend one of our Catholic Schools in St. Joseph, and donors will be able to receive special tax credits for their donations.

This new law provides state tax credits for contributions to Educational Assistance Organizations (EAOs). The Diocese of Kansas City's Bright Futures Fund has been designated as an EAO.

The contributions made by donors are used to award scholarships to Missouri students with Individual Education Plans (IEPs) and students living in low-income households.

Incoming kindergarteners and first graders who meet the income threshold or have an IEP are eligible to receive scholarships. Families with children in other grades must have been enrolled in a public or charter school. Current Catholic school families in grades 2-12 are not eligible to participate.
