#### Come Home to Communion

Bishop Johnston wrote in his letter: "As circumstances have significantly improved due to the availability of vaccines and other factors, I withdraw the general dispensation from the holy obligation to participate in Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation effective June 1, 2021, in advance of the Feast of Corpus Christi June 5-6, 2021. Those with serious health concerns, pre-existing conditions, or who are caregivers to the vulnerable continue to have the grant of a particular dispensation.

I invite all who are no longer dispensed to 'Come Home to Communion'. I invite you to return to the Real Presence of Christ with your real presence at the Mass. If you have returned to the grocery store, the gym, the office or dining in restaurants, you can feel safe in returning to church. 
