Beloved Parishioners,

My time in St. Joseph is drawing to a close. Soon I'll depart for my summer assignment to serve the poor in downtown Kansas City, after which I'll return to the seminary for two more years. This pastoral year has been a profound experience for me. I am not sure I can adequately comprehend what it has done to my heart and mind. I have been formed, yes. I have grown and learned and matured. Above all, I have known the Father's love through His people.

In ten months, God-willing, I will formally ask the Church to ordain me to the diaconate with the intention of requesting the priesthood the following year. The pastoral year, among other things, was supposed to help me better know what to expect as a priest—to feel out the vocation and to make use of the skills and formation I've received. Has this been accomplished? I can say yes with much confidence.

I am immensely grateful for so many of you who have assisted, encouraged, supported, and prayed for me. Your prayer, especially, has impacted me. How many times was I invisibly strengthened during some ministerial experience because of the graces which you interceded for on my behalf? My faith compels me to believe that more often than not, you were the reason I was a vessel for the Lord.

So, thank you for permitting me to share in your lives for the last 9 months. Please continue to pray for me and for all seminarians. As a final thank-you, I will be hosting whoever wants to join for ice cream following my last Masses at St. Mary's and Cathedral. At St. Mary's it will be May 11. At Cathedral, I will be June 1 after the 11:30 AM Mass.
