Father Stephen Hansen's Message

The month of May is dedicated to Mary in the Church year. We have May Crownings (next Friday, at 8:00 am Mass and on Saturday at the 4:00 pm Mass). We have the Memorial of Our Lady of Fatima, and we have "Mother's Day". Mary is Jesus' Mother, and ours due to our Lord's words on the cross to St. John (and therefore us), "*Then he said to the disciple, 'Behold, your mother!' And from that hour the disciple took her to his own home.*" ~ John 19:27

Maybe you would consider praying a decade of the Rosary after dinner each night. One custom - that is a nice way of venerating Mary - is to make a pilgrimage to a shrine, church named after her, or even to any statue of Mary. You could take your spouse, children, a friend. Pray one five-decade Rosary on the way to Mary's statue, one Rosary at the statue, and one on the way home. Of course, there may be time to talk about Mary, Joseph, and Jesus on the journey, deepening the faith of all!

On May 13th we'll be consecrating the St. Joseph Catholic Academy to Jesus through Mary! We're doing this inspired by Benedictine College's consecration through Mary a number of years ago.

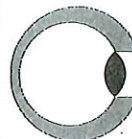

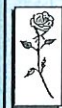
